## **REPORTS OF OFFICERS**

**Center Park Shelter:** Council Member Giese made a motion to authorize the Public Works Supervisor to replace two posts at the Center Park shelter, at his discretion, due to safety concerns. Council Member McGillivray seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Resolution 202512: Council Member Clark made a motion to approve Resolution 202512 A Resolution Opting To Join The Statewide Volunteer Firefighter Plan per the Fire Relief Association's request to transfer its Special Fund to the PERA program, effective January 1, 2026. Council Member McGillivray seconded the motion. Mayor Lindstrand called for a voice vote: Mayor Lindstrand – Yes, Council Members: Clark - Yes, McGillivray - Yes, Hunt - Absent, and Giese – Abstain. Motion carried with Council Member Giese abstaining for conflict of interest.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Resolution 202515: Council Member Clark motioned to accept Resolution 202515 A Resolution Approving Plans And Specifications And Ordering Advertisement For Bids. This allows the bidding process to start for Phase I Street & Utility Improvement Project, the improvement of McDermott Avenue between 4th Street and 7th Street, Pacific Avenue, Mclaughlin Avenue from 2nd Street to mid-block of 3rd and 4th Street, 7th Street south of US HWY 12, 6th Street south of US HWY12, 5th Street south of US HWY 12, 4th Street south of US HWY 12, and 3rd Street between Mclaughlin Avenue and Atlantic Avenue. Council Member Giese seconded the motion. Mayor Lindstrand called for a voice vote: Clark - Yes, McGillivray - Yes, Hunt - Absent, and Giese – Yes. Motion carried.

# **Interim Phase I Project Financing:**

Council Member Giese motioned to authorize Clerk/Treasurer Woltjer to proceed with applying to the Minnesota Rural Water Association (MRWA) for interim construction financing program and to initiate the process if their interest rate is determined to be lower. Council Member Clark seconded the motion. Mayor Lindstrand called for a voice vote: Clark - Yes, McGillivray - Yes, Hunt - Absent, and Giese – Yes. Motion carried.

Council Member Giese motioned to authorize Clerk/Treasurer Woltjer to proceed with applying through Kandiyohi Power Cooperative in partnership with Great River Energy for interim financing and to begin the process if their interest rate is lower. Council Member Clark seconded the motion. Mayor Lindstrand called for a voice vote: Clark - Yes, McGillivray - Yes, Hunt - Absent, and Giese – Yes. Motion carried.
